



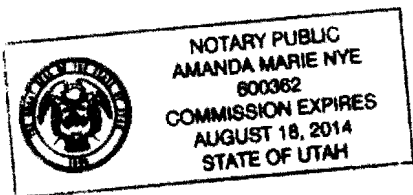

Logan Municipal Council

The Municipal Council of the City of Logan, Utah will hold public hearings to consider the following:

An adjustment to the FY 2013-2014 budget appropriating: \$54,400 funds received from the State of Utah for the Willow Park Zoo operating expenses; \$300 for a grant awarded to the Police Department for the purchase of bullet proof vests; \$32,730 for a grant awarded to Parks & Recreation for their After School Program; \$38,990 for the reimbursement of wildland fire deployments (Black Mountain Fire and State Fire); \$10,000 for a grant awarded to the Police Department for the Operation Crosswalk Enforcement Program; \$3,000 for restricted employee donations for the employee fund.

Consideration of a proposed resolution approving the Adams Neighborhood Specific Plan.
