**A RESOLUTION ON ELECTED OFFICIALS' WAGES**

WHEREAS, the City has established a pay program which has been adopted and implemented by the Logan Municipal Council; and

WHEREAS, the City annually surveys other local government positions throughout the State of Utah which includes an annual market study in order to identify prevailing wages for comparable positions in the Logan City corporation; and

WHEREAS, this survey also includes wage data for local government elected officials.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that elected officials' wages shall be identified, reviewed, and adjusted annually in accordance with the same procedures applied to all other City employees in the budget process. The public hearing for elected officials' wages shall be held as part of the hearing(s) for the annual budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there be no adjustments to the wages of any elected official.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution in compliance with Municipal Council Resolution No. 05-58.

**F/Y 2014-2015 TENTATIVE BUDGET ADOPTION**

The Logan Municipal Council will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, June 17, 2014 not before 6:00 p.m. in the Municipal Council Chambers, 290 North 100 West, Logan, Utah, to consider the following:

1. The tentative adoption of the budgets for F/Y 2014-15, including the water and sewer funds, electric fund, environmental health fund, general fund, library fund, capital improvement fund, and other funds.
2. The setting of salaries for elected and appointed officials.

The budget is presented as a balanced budget with projected revenues and requested expenditures in the amount of \$143,837,074.

The final budget will be approved and adopted following a Truth-in-Taxation hearing tentatively scheduled on August 5, 2014.
