

The Municipal Council of the City of Logan, Utah will hold a public hearing to consider the following:

Consideration of a proposed adjustment to the FY 2014-2015 budget appropriating: \$480,925 funds the City of Logan was awarded for the Logan River Restoration Project from Cache County; \$35,000 for the UCAIR Grant Award for the purchase of an electric vehicle, charging station and anti idling signs; \$6,510 for the purchase of the acquisitions module of the existing Logan City Library software from restricted reserves (292105); \$65,894 funds received from the State of Utah for the Alcohol Enforcement Program; \$3,570 for the asset forfeiture shed from restricted reserves (\$3,570 from 292103) and police forfeitures.
