

**CITY OF LOGAN  
RESOLUTION NO. 18-12**

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) ANNUAL ACTION PLAN (PROGRAM YEAR 2018) FOR THE CITY OF LOGAN.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Logan (City) was designated a Metropolitan Statistical Area in May, 2003; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is required to develop an Annual Action Plan each year for submission for approval to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), which plans delineate funding allocations to CDBG subrecipients and strategic priorities and a community needs assessment; and

**WHEREAS**, it is estimated that the City will receive \$430,000 to allocate from HUD for PY2018; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has complied with the applicable requirements approved by HUD and outlined in the City's Five-Year Consolidated Plan, which requires that:


- a steering committee is formed to meet and review each eligible application for funding and to come to a unanimous consensus for a recommendation; which recommendation includes funding allocations and funding conditions; and which is submitted for approval to the collective City Council; and
- specified public hearings are held, notices are published, and the Annual Action Plan under consideration is made available for public review and comment in accordance with the Citizen Participation Plan.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOGAN, UTAH:**


1. The PY2018 Annual Action Plan, including funding decision, the summary of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, is hereby adopted by the City of Logan and approved to be submitted to HUD.
2. This resolution shall be effective immediately as of the date of its adoption.

## **EXHIBIT A**

### **PY2018 Annual Action Plan Funding Recommendations Summary**

#### **Application Period**

The Logan City CDBG Program held an application period from February 23, 2018, to March 20, 2018. During the application period, two application workshops were offered to provide potential applications with an opportunity to learn about application requirements. City Departments and nonprofits serving low/moderate income residents were invited to make application.

#### **CDBG Program Year 2018 Funding Recommendation**

Logan City's CDBG program is estimated to receive \$430,00 in CDBG funding for PY2018. The CDBG Steering Committee met on March 28, 2018, and made the following funding recommendation:

- \$100,000 - 200 E 800 N Sidewalk
- \$180,000 - Center Street Pedestrian Improvements\*
- \$25,000 - Bridger Bike Park
- \$10,000 - Ellen Eccles Theatre Accessible Seating
- \$30,000 - LCSD Preschool Playground
- \$20,000 - The Family Place Sports Court
- \$65,000 - CDBG Program Administration

\*It is recommended that if the Center Street Pedestrian Improvements project is cancelled then \$110,00 will be reallocated to 300 W 600 S Sidewalks, and \$70,000 will be reallocated to 200 W 1300 S Sidewalk.

Any PY2018 funds awarded by HUD in excess of the estimate or any funds recaptured from any other CDBG activity from any program year will be reallocated to the 300 W 600 S Sidewalk up a total project funding of \$130,000.

#### **Public Review and Comment Period**

A public review and comment period regarding the proposed PY2018 Annual Action Plan runs from March 30, 2018 to May 1, 2018.

#### **Public Hearing**

A public hearing is scheduled for May 1, 2018, for the purpose of receiving public input by Logan residents regarding the proposed plan. The hearing takes place as part of the regularly scheduled City Council meeting, which begins at 5:30pm. Logan City Hall is located at 290 N 100 W, Logan.
