RESOLUTION NO. 18-43

A RESOLUTION UPDATING THE COMPLETE LIST OF LOGAN CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT FEES, TO ESTABLISH A FEE AMOUNT FOR MANDATORY DATA CHIP PLACEMENT ON ANY DOG THAT IS IMPOUNDED BY LOGAN CITY ANIMAL CONTROL PRIOR TO RELEASE BACK TO THE OWNER, ADOPTION FEE OF AN ANIMAL AND APPROVE AN INCREASE IN FEES CHARGED FOR THE PRIVATE HIRING OF LOGAN CITY POLICE OFFICERS FOR TRAFFIC DETAILS, SECURITY OR OTHER ASSIGNMENTS.

WHEREAS, Logan City Police Department seeks to update the single resolution document outlining all Police Department fees.

WHEREAS, Logan City Police Department provides animal control services to Logan City residents, and as part of these services, it is necessary at times to impound animals and board animals. Whereas, Prior to the release of impounded animals, Logan City Police Department will require the animal to receive a data chip placed prior to its release back to its owner. Whereas, costs for placing the chip needs to be established at \$20 per chip.

WHEREAS, Logan City Police Department has occasional need to adopt impounded animals that remain unclaimed for over five business days. Whereas there are legal requirements established by the State of Utah that require Logan City Police to either spay or neuter an animal prior to adoption. Whereas there are costs associated with having a veterinarian spay or neuter the animal and costs to providing a microchip and license. Whereas Logan City Police Department establish a fee of \$45, for adoption of a pet that is spayed or neutered that includes licensing and a microchip. Whereas Logan City Police Department establish a fee of \$175, for adoption of a pet that needs spay or neuter this fee will also include a Logan City license and a microchip.

WHEREAS, Logan City Police Department is frequently solicited for many different situations to provide police services for private groups, individuals or businesses. Whereas, overtime is payed to all non-exempt employees that fill these shifts. Whereas, the dollar per hour fee needs to be increased such that the City is fully compensated.

WHEREAS, Logan City Police Department seeks to increase the fee to hire Logan City Police Officers for private traffic services, security or other specific assignments. Whereas, Logan City Police Department currently charges \$50.00 per hour. Whereas, many comparative Utah cities vary between \$60 and \$75 per hour. Whereas the Logan City Police Department seeks to increase the dollar per hour fee to \$70.
