The Municipal Council of the City of Logan, Utah will hold a public hearing to consider the following:

An adjustment to the FY 2019-2020 budget appropriating: \$70,000 Community Development Rolling Stock reserves toward the purchase of two vehicles; \$3,000 a grant the Library received from the State of Utah for Census outreach; \$11,200 funds the Library received from State of Utah for collection development, technology and community outreach; \$980 a reimbursement the Police Department received for enforcement of events requested by businesses; \$60,000 a grant awarded from the UDOT for a study of the Main Street Corridor; \$102,253 a grant from the CMPO for the study of the Main Street Corridor; \$40,000 funds the City will receive from Cigna to promote the city employee wellness program.
