

**CITY OF LOGAN  
RESOLUTION NO. 20-14**

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG)  
ANNUAL ACTION PLAN (PROGRAM YEAR 2020) FOR THE CITY OF LOGAN.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Logan (City) was designated a Metropolitan Statistical Area in May of 2003; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is required to develop an Annual Action Plan each year for submission for approval to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The plan delineates funding allocations to CDBG sub-recipients, strategic priorities and a community needs assessment; and

**WHEREAS**, the City will receive \$509,822 to allocate from HUD for PY2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has complied with the applicable requirements approved by HUD and outlined in the City's Five-Year Consolidated Plan, which requires that:

- A steering committee is formed to meet and review each eligible application for funding and to come to a unanimous consensus for a recommendation; which recommendation includes funding allocations and funding conditions; and which is submitted for approval to the collective City Council; and
- Specified public hearings are held, notices are published, and the Annual Action Plan under consideration is made available for public review and comment in accordance with the Citizen Participation Plan.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOGAN,  
UTAH:**

1. The PY2020 Annual Action Plan, including funding decision, the summary of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, is hereby adopted by the City of Logan and approved to be submitted to HUD.
2. This resolution shall be effective immediately, as of the date of its adoption.

## EXHIBIT A

### **PY2020 Annual Action Plan Funding Recommendations Summary**

#### Application Period

The Logan City CDBG Program held an application period from February 19, 2020, to March 19, 2020. During the application period, two application workshops were offered to provide potential applications with an opportunity to learn about application requirements. City Departments and nonprofits serving low/moderate income residents were invited to make application.

#### CDBG Program Year 2020 Funding Recommendation

Logan City's CDBG program will receive \$509,822 in funding for PY2020. The CDBG Steering Committee met April 28, 2020, and made the following funding recommendation:

\$ 45,000 – 600 N. 200 W. Sidewalk  
\$ 61,058 – 500 W. 400 S. Sidewalk \*  
\$ 66,000 – 1200 N. 200 W. Intersection Alignment  
\$ 46,000 – 750 N. 600 E. Sidewalk & Retaining Wall  
\$ 35,000 – 500 N. 500 E. ADA Ramps  
\$ 9,800 – Cache County Senior Center Parking Lot Repair  
\$ 40,000 – Cache County Senior Center Asbestos Removal  
\$ 14,500 – Sunshine Terrace Memory Care Courtyard Improvement  
\$ 32,000 – The Family Place Post Frame Shed  
\$ 13,000 – Cache Humane Society Feline Spay/Neuter Vouchers  
\$ 16,000 – CAPSA Technology Improvement  
\$ 29,500 – English Language Center Smartboard Technology  
\$101,964 – CDBG Program Administration & Planning  
**\$509,822 - TOTAL ALLOCATION**
