**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FORMAL REQUEST OF WITHDRAWAL BY
THE CITY OF LOGAN FROM THE NORTHERN UTAH ENVIRONMENTAL
RESOURCE AGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City of Logan is a member of the interlocal entity called the Northern Utah Environmental Resource Agency (“NUERA”); and

WHEREAS, the City of Logan has determined that its membership in NUERA is no longer useful or necessary; and

WHEREAS, the City of Logan now desires to withdraw its membership from NUERA.


NOW, THEREFORE, RESOLVED BY THE LOGAN CITY COUNCIL as follows:

1. **Approval to Withdraw.** The Logan City Council hereby formally approves and requests withdrawal from NUERA and authorizes the Mayor and staff to execute the necessary documents to accomplish said withdrawal, pursuant to section 12 of the Agreement To Create Northern Utah Environmental Resource Agency entered into October 28, 2014.


2. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage and adoption.

RESOLUTION NO. 20-04**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE WITHDRAWAL OF
LOGAN CITY AS A MEMBER OF NUERA**

WHEREAS, Northern Utah Environmental Resource Agency (“NUERA”) was established for the mutual benefit of its six members entities; and

WHEREAS, since the date of establishing NUERA, individual entities have moved forward with various projects both individually and jointly; and

WHEREAS, Logan City has moved forward with the construction and now operation of its municipal solid waste facility in Clarkston, Utah; and

WHEREAS, other member entities such as North Pointe Solid Waste Special Service District, South Utah Valley Special Waste District, Trans-Jordan Cities, and Wasatch Integrated Waste Management District, have moved forward with the Bayview Landfill Project; and

WHEREAS, Logan City has made the decision that the benefit of belonging to NUERA, while not contrary to the desires and goals of Logan City, is no longer of prime importance to the City; and

WHEREAS, Article 12 of the Interlocal Agreement permits a member to withdraw upon given the required notice and the adoption of resolution expressing the desire to withdraw; and

WHEREAS, there are no outstanding financial obligations of Logan City to NUERA and Logan City has complied with all of the requirements set forth in Article 12 of the Interlocal Agreement providing for withdrawal of a member entity; and


WHEREAS, Logan City has provided a resolution adopted by the governing body of the city expressing their desire to withdraw from NUERA effective at least 180 days in the future, attached as Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of NUERA as follows:


1. The Board acknowledges the receipt of the resolution expressing the desire of Logan City to withdraw as a member of NUERA.
2. Effective April 9, 2021, 180 days from the approval of this resolution, the request of Logan City to withdraw from NUERA shall cease to be a member of NUERA.
