**A RESOLUTION TO ACKNOWLEDGE AND SUPPORT A GRANT APPLICATION (DEADLINE MAY 1, 2021) TO
THE LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND BY THE CITY OF LOGAN FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS
AT THE WILLOW PARK SPORTS COMPLEX**

WHEREAS, the City of Logan owns property and facilities dedicated for the purpose of public recreation for its citizens and the general public use; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Department manages, operates, and maintains designated properties such as the Willow Park Sports Complex for public use; and

WHEREAS, the Department proposes to replace backstops, dugouts, outfield fences, and two infields at the Willow Park Sports Complex; and


WHEREAS, the Land and Water Conservation Fund is a 50-50 split cost sharing reimbursement grant program that requires matching dollars by the Applicant (Parks and Recreation Department); and

WHEREAS, the City's annual budgetary process is independent of the Land and Water Conservation Fund grant selection process; and

WHEREAS, the Land and Water Conservation Fund grant program, administered by the Utah Department of Natural Resources Utah State Parks, includes a pre-application review process after the application deadline that may take up to twelve (12) months to complete before approval notification is given and therefore project funding from the City is planned accordingly to coincide with the City's Fiscal Year 2023.


