

**CITY OF LOGAN, UTAH  
RESOLUTION NO. 22-03**

**A RESOLUTION CREATING LOGAN CITY SCHOOL BOARD DISTRICTS  
(OPTION 2)**

**WHEREAS**, Utah Code Ann. § 20A-14-201 provides that the municipal legislative body for local school districts contained completely within a municipality shall divide the school district into local school board districts; and

**WHEREAS**, the Logan City School District is contained completely within the boundaries of the City of Logan; and


**WHEREAS**, the Council finds that the proposed local school board districts described below are contiguous and compact and have substantially equal population.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE LOGAN MUNICIPAL COUNCIL**, adopts five local school board districts within the City of Logan and illustrated in the attached map. These five local school board districts are described as follows:


- District 1: Precinct # 1, 2, 9, 15, 22 = 3,830 voters
- District 2: Precinct # 3, 4, 5, 12, 13 = 3,989 voters
- District 3: Precinct # 6, 7, 8, 10, 11, 14 = 3,353 voters
- District 4: Precinct # 18, 19, 20, 21 = 3,679 voters
- District 5: Precinct # 16, 17, 23, 24, 24, 25 = 3,850 voters

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval.
