The Municipal Council of the City of Logan, Utah will hold a public hearing to consider the following: Adjustments to the FY 2022-2023 budget appropriating: \$20,000 EMS reserves toward EMS inventory equipment; \$14,179 State grant funds for the purchase of police body cameras; \$151,800 funds the Fire Department received from the State of Utah to provide first responders with mental health support and resources; \$145,001 a grant Parks & Recreation received from the State of Utah to be used for improvements at the Willow Pak Sports Complex; \$53,433 a grant Parks & Recreation received from the Cache County Trails Department to be used to create a pedestrian crossing on 1400 North to access the Middle Canal Trail; \$3,318 funds to be received from the US Department of Justice for federal cases worked by police officers; \$21,418 funds received for police overtime shift reimbursements; \$185,525 wildland fire reimbursements.
