





I've ran what is marked as the 'Westside Trail' and this is NOT a trail??? This is a road. You have to cross several busy roads that include 2nd North and Center Street not to mention there are tons of stop signs and it is not lit in the dark hours?? Also, running along/across the busy streets does not constitute as getting any fresh air. This is your average road. It is a little better than some I've seen marked as a bike route that are oneway streets without a shoulder, but there is nothing special about it. My husband and I looked at your map before we left to take the kids in the bike trailer hoping we would find something safe and yet here is a word to the wise - this is not it. We found ourselves on busy streets with lots of industrial traffic. We did that route the one time and that will be our only time. Sure there is a the trail by the golf course that is paved and away from the cars - it's 1.7 miles and I think that is if you walk along the shoulder of the highway for part of it.. Otherwise I believe it is about one mile of a safe trail. One would go crazy if they were to run back and forth on this trail 26.2 times. And because it is one of the only two paved trails (both only reaching about 1 mile) in Logan that is safe and away fro the road, it is usually quite busy to say the least. We are a great city!! One of the best in Utah I would say! I also believe that we have enough interested, active people, not to mention the THOUSANDS of students who attend the university that add to the area to justify SOMETHING being done. I hope I get to live here for a long time. However, if I ever have to move there are two things I will say 'good ridden' to: the inversion and the 'bike routes'...
