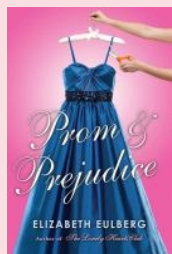

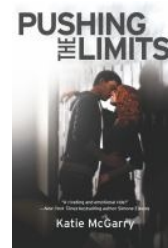
Cinderella is dead

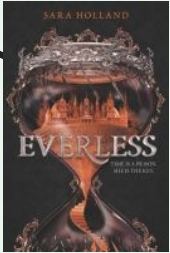


Lady Midnight

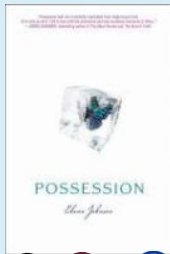


Ivory and bone

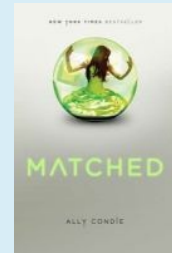
The Program
