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



SUMMARY OF ISSUE/TOPIC:

Family Services staff is requesting additional funds to pay Vanderpool, Fostick & Nishanian legal fees. The current budget for Family Services legal fees has a remaining balance of \$2,038. The Department's monthly invoices have been averaging \$20,000.

The Family Services Fund has salary savings to cover the \$60,000. A Social Worker position was vacant for 8 months and then filled with an individual whose salary is lower than budgeted resulting in savings of approximately \$57,000. A Social Worker Aide position has also been vacant since the beginning of the fiscal year resulting in savings of approximately \$10,000.

This resolution will transfer \$60,000 of salary savings in the Family Services Fund.
