Manassas City Police Crime Report

On Wednesday, Aug. 24, officers responded to shots fired on Bruton Parish Court. Shell casings were found along with damage to two vehicles and a residence. No one was hurt during this incident. On Wednesday, Aug. 24 at 11:58 p.m. officers responded to a hit and run accident at the intersection of Digges Road and Forum Way. After interviewing a group of people in the area, it was determined that the suspect vehicle was in the vicinity. Once located, officers acted to intervene on foot when the driver intentionally swerved toward the officers while accelerating. Officers were able to move out of the way and proceeded to pursue the vehicle by car. A chase ensued into Prince William County with helicopter and K9 support with negative results. As the scene was being cleared an officer observed the subject on foot and was able to take him into custody without incident. Subject is identified as Dale Caison, Jr. of Fort Pulaski Court in Dumfries. He is being charged with attempted malicious wounding on Law Enforcement Officers, felony eluding, felony hit and run and driving on a revoked license.

On Aug. 23, Manassas City Officers and the Prince William, Manassas and Manassas Park Narcotics Task Force assisted Fairfax County Police in the arrest of three individuals on narcotics charges. Kiet T. Ly of Sandalwood Drive in Manassas was arrested for possession with intent to distribute marijuana over 5 lbs. and manufacturing marijuana. Lidia Lopez was arrested with the same charges. In a separate incident, Police arrested Victor Alan Painter of York Drive in Woodbridge on the following charges: conspiracy to violate the drug control act, distribution of a sch I/II drug, and possession with intent to distribute a sch I/II drug.

On Aug. 22, 2016, Manassas City Police responded to Sumner Lake Boulevard for a report of larceny from a vehicle. The victim reports that a pocketknife and sunglasses were taken from the vehicle.
