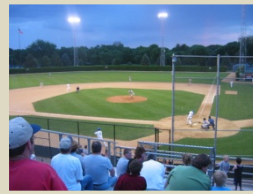

Why Support the Endowment Fund?

The Capstone Endowment Fund exists to provide donors with tax-efficient charitable gift planning for community enhancements in Marshall. Your gift will support the growth of the permanent fund that will in turn provide more annual earnings to distribute to projects. The Mayor and City Council selects projects based on a meritorious review with priority on those that meet the goals of the community, leverage other sources of funds and have a demonstrated community support. Funding has supported meaningful multi-generational projects including the new Marshall-Lyon County Library construction, Sounds of Summer community festival and technology enhancements for seniors at the Adult Community Center.

About the Capstone Endowment Fund

In 2012, the Mayor and City Council of Marshall created a lasting legacy to Marshall through the creation of the Capstone Endowment Fund. Two million dollars that had been received by the City through the privatization of the Weiner Memorial Hospital to Avera were permanently designated to be used for community enhancements. The fund uses interest earnings to fund pilot programs or capital projects that provide particular benefit to the community that would not otherwise happen through traditional limited funds of the City.

Ways to Give

Memorial Gifts

Gifts honoring relatives, friends or a special occasion. A card will be sent on your behalf from the Mayor to the person whom you are honoring, but will not mention the donation amount.

Planned Gifts

Leaving a bequest to the foundation in your will or trust is an easy way to make a significant impact and receive tax considerations at the same time.

Designated Gifts

Important items are often needed but cannot be funded within the City's budget. An alternative to gifting the capstone endowment fund you may contribute to a specific use. Donors may request a current wish list.
