



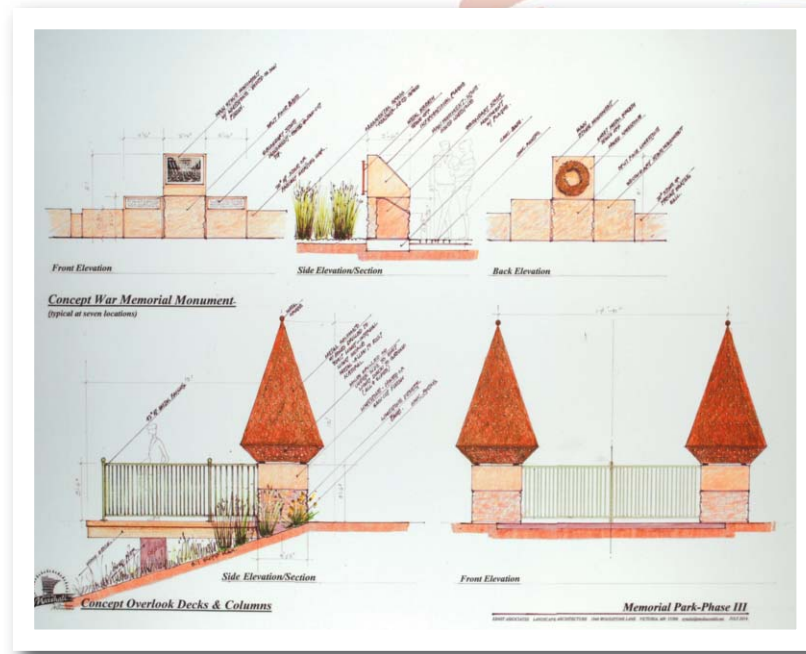
In Remembrance...

Memorial Park FINAL PHASE



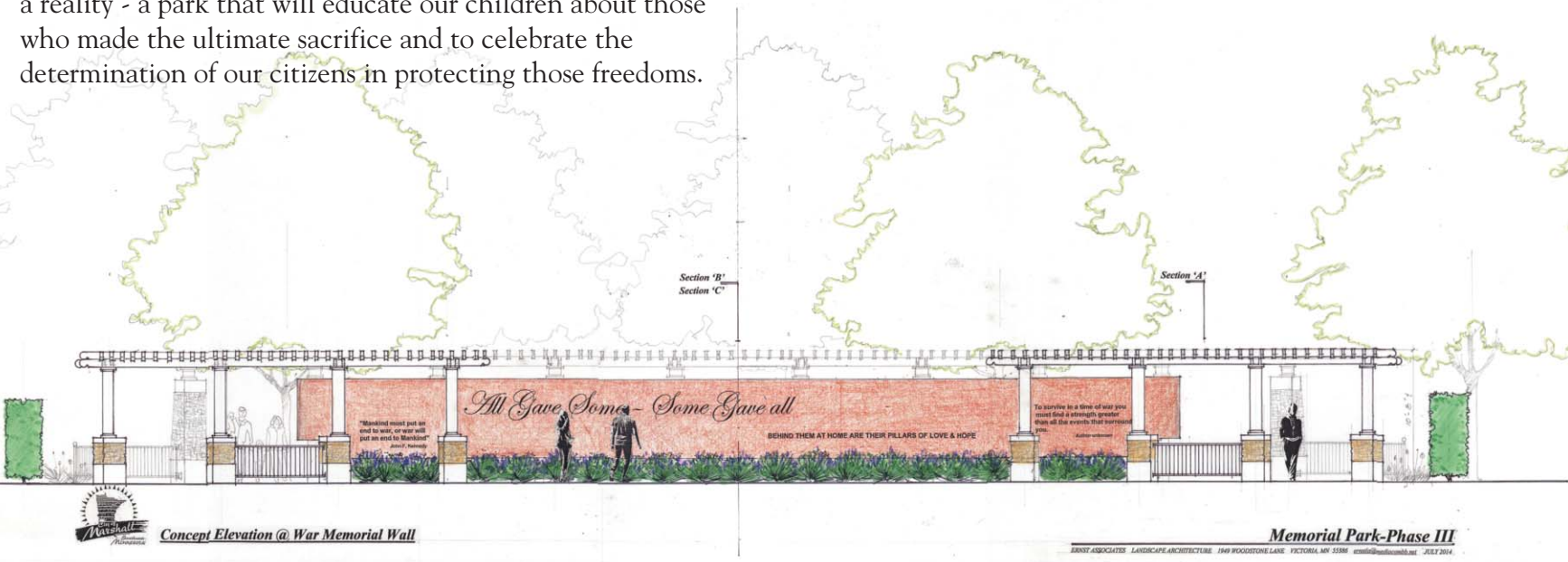
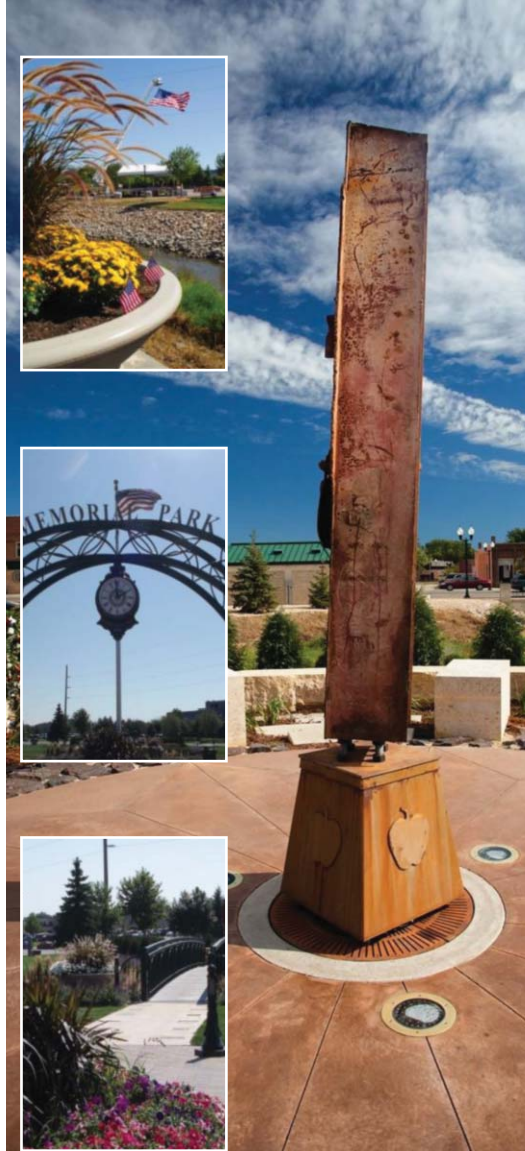

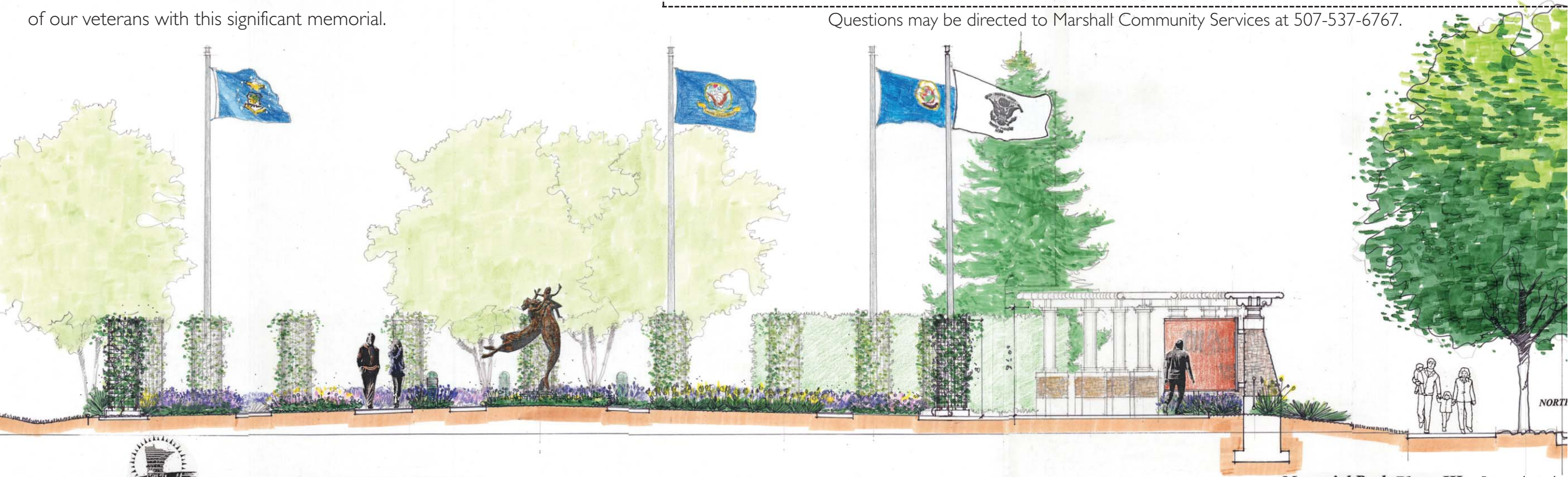
