

SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL INFORMATIONAL MEETING – JULY 23, 2014


There was a Special City/County Informational Meeting held on July 23, 2014 in the Lyon County Commissioners Room at the Lyon County Government Center, 607 West Main Street. Lyon County Commissioner, Steve Ritter, called the meeting of the Lyon County Commissioners to order at 7:00 P.M. Council Members in attendance included: Ellayne Conyers, Larry Doom, Jennie Hulsizer, Glenn Bayerkohler and John DeCramer. Staff present included: Ben Martig, City Administrator and Thomas M. Meulebroeck, Finance Director/City Clerk.

The purpose of this meeting was to receive input on the Marshall/Lyon County Library / Plum Creek Regional System.
