REVIEW COMMUNITY SERVICES 2017 BUDGET:


Nick Johnson, City Administrator, reviewed the proposed 2017 Community Services Budget, which included: Adult Community Center; Aquatic Center; Cable Commission; Community Education Fall, Summer, Winter; Community Service Administration; Community Services Fund; Community Services – Other; Community Services – Youth Activities; Municipal Bank; Park Maintenance and Development; and Recreation Fall, Summer and Winter.

REVIEW WASTEWATER AND STORMWATER FEES:

Nick Johnson, City Administrator, reviewed the Wastewater and Stormwater Fees for 2017. There was considerable discussion on the proposed increases.


