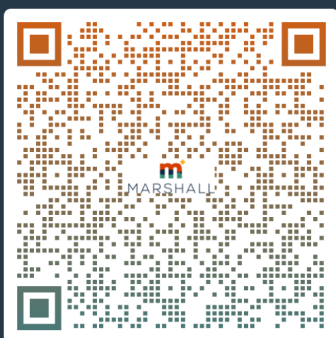

Project Updates

Z51-2021 and Z88 – Mill & Overlay Projects



OVERVIEW

The City of Marshall will be completing two mill and overlay projects on several streets within the City this construction season. This type of improvement is not currently assessed to the adjacent property owners.

As part of the mill and overlay project, sidewalk ramps will be reconstructed to meet current federal accessibility requirements. The reconstruction of the ramps may require some grade adjustments to the ramp, landing or adjacent sidewalk to meet the current standards.

RESIDENT CONSIDERATIONS

The Public Works Department and Contractors will strive to minimize disruption to the residents along the overlay routes. However, there will be short periods during paving when the new surface will be inaccessible for traveling, usually limited to a couple hours. New pedestrian ramps will be inaccessible for a few days after the initial concrete pouring.

If you have irrigation near the sidewalk, please be prepared to mark all sprinkler heads, locate irrigation lines, and/or relocate irrigation or sprinkler heads. It is the responsibility of the property owner to identify the location and make arrangements for any removal or relocation of private improvements prior to the contractor's work near the property.



The Contractor will place No Parking signs prior to work beginning on mill and overlay routes. Please plan to have any vehicles removed from the street prior to 6:30 a.m. the day of milling. If vehicles remain on the City street, your vehicle may be towed. If you anticipate an extended absence this construction season, please make arrangements to have anything located on the City street removed. If weather conditions delay construction, milling will resume on the next day.

If you live along Southview Drive (between Saratoga Street and Main Street) or on E. Lyon Street (between Adobe Road and MN Highway 23), you should have received a flyer last month regarding changes to the lanes along those streets. Shortly after the overlay has completed, the Contractor will be restriping the new lane configurations as shown in the flyer. Please be prepared for these changes when they occur.
