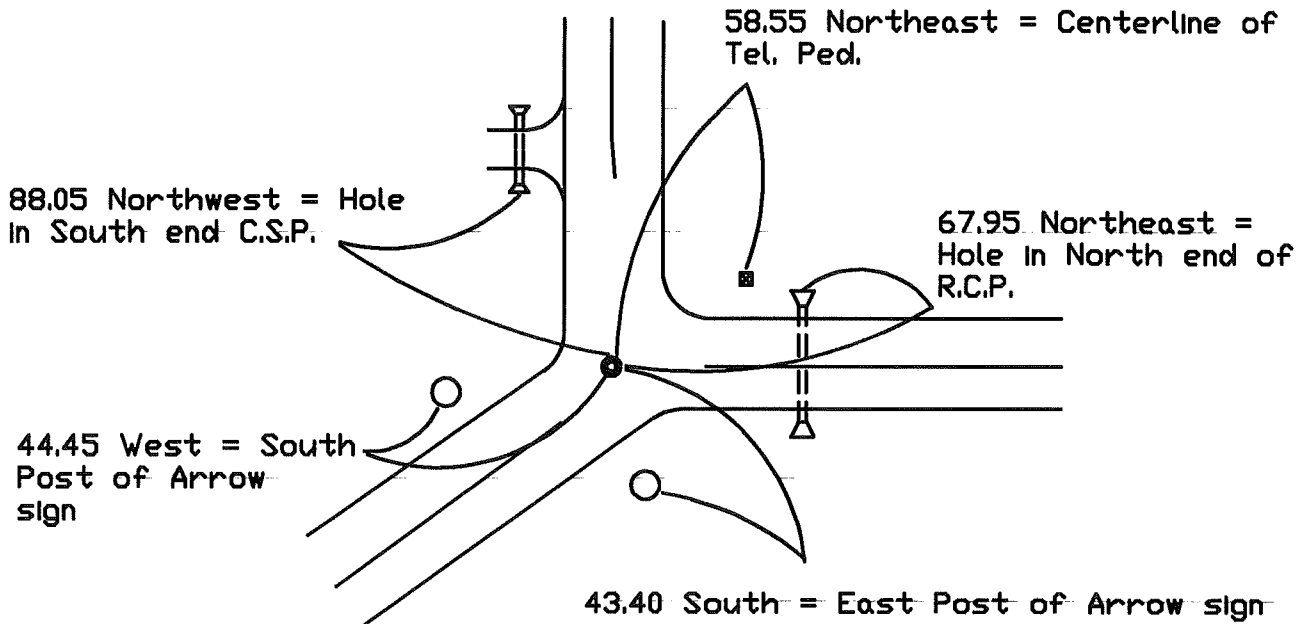

Statement of Evidence

The corner was originally established during the Public Land Survey of 1857, by John O. Brunius.

According to the recorded Certificate of Location, Doc. No. 255382 Date, July 11, 1972, the corner was a stone "+" (18" deep), with a 2 x 2 stake over stone. On Sept. 7, 1977, a 3/4" iron pin was set over stone, (3" deep).

On July 28, 1993, I found a 3/4" iron rod (4" deep)
