

Statement of Evidence:

The corner was originally established during the public land survey which was completed in 1857.

A survey made by C.J. Montgomery, dated April, 1891, in County Surveyor's Book B, page 68, indicates he drove a small oak stake and raised mound and pits.

A survey made by George E. Sawyer, dated August, 1900, in County Surveyor's Book D, page 22, indicates the corner was plowed out and he set a 22" x 16" x 12" grey granite with "+".

The Martin County Highway Dept, in April, 1954, described the corner as a stone "+" (12" deep) with 3/4" steel rod over stone (4" deep). No remaining ties.

On 12/5/80, I found a 3/4" steel rod (4" deep).
