Maintenance Rescheduled for Monday, February 3, 2020

The Water Conservation Advisory for the water customers of Martin County Water District 1 in the area north of the Town of Hamilton has been extended. Maintenance on the main water line that serves the area north of the Town of Hamilton was scheduled for Friday, January 31, 2020, but has been rescheduled for Monday, February 3, 2020.

The Martin County Water Department will be performing repairs to a County water main within the Town of Hamilton on Monday, February 3, 2020, beginning at 8:00 a.m. Customers in the areas listed below may experience low pressure or total loss of water throughout Monday, February 3, 2020:

- All customers within the Oak City Town Limits,
- Barnes Lane,
- Bennett Road,
- Cannon Road,
- Clayton House Road,
- David Brown Road,
- Deer Run,
- Edmondson Road,
- Harrell Road,
- Harvest Lane,

- Highway 11 (from Oak City Town Limits to the Old Cotton Road),
- Highway 11 (between Bennett Road and Ray Turner Road),
- Highway 111 (from Oak City Town Limits to Owen Jones Road),
- Highway 125 north of Hamilton to north of Oak City to the Smith Road,
- Highway 903 (from north of Hamilton to the Halifax County Line),
- Hines Road,
- Part of Hassell Road between Oak City Town Limits and Hines Road,
- Mayo Farm Road,
- Owen Jones Road,
- Ray Turner Road,
- Red Oak Fork Road,
- Roy Beach Road, and
- Williams Road.

Additional advisories will be issued as needed.

This office is strongly urging the water consumers to conserve water whenever possible. This advisory remains in effect until further written notification is issued.
