

NOTICE INVITING BIDS

The Martin County Board of Commissioners is seeking bids from interested and qualified firms to provide site services to construct a 2-mile natural surface equine trail located at 104 Kehukee Park Road in Williamston. Sealed bids will be received by the Office of the County Manager at 305 East Main Street, Williamston, NC. 27892 until the hour of 2:00 p.m., on September 12, 2023. Awards are expected to be announced within 10 days in order to meet the project completion deadline of November 1, 2023.

PROJECT NAME: Kehukee Park Road Equine Trail Phase I

PROJECT SCOPE:

Martin County owns an 85-acre tract which has recently undergone a clear-cut forestry operation (Fall of 2018) on approximately 66 acres. The County seeks to develop these 66 acres to provide increased recreational use by the public. Given the tract's close proximity (located across Kehukee Park Road) to Martin Community College (MCC) campus and its renowned Equine Training Technology and Equine Business Training Technology academic programs, and in coordination with the NC Cooperative Extension Service's 4-H Plant and Animal Science Program featuring its Youth Equine Program - it is readily apparent that a system of Equine Trails and associated amenities will serve as a viable option for an improved public-use recreational land-use.

Approximately 2.0 miles of new Equine Trails (10' width) is planned for construction, beginning at the existing Martin County Soil and Water Offices at 104 Kehukee Park Road and terminating with a load/unload drive-through for connectivity to and across from MCC Equine facilities.

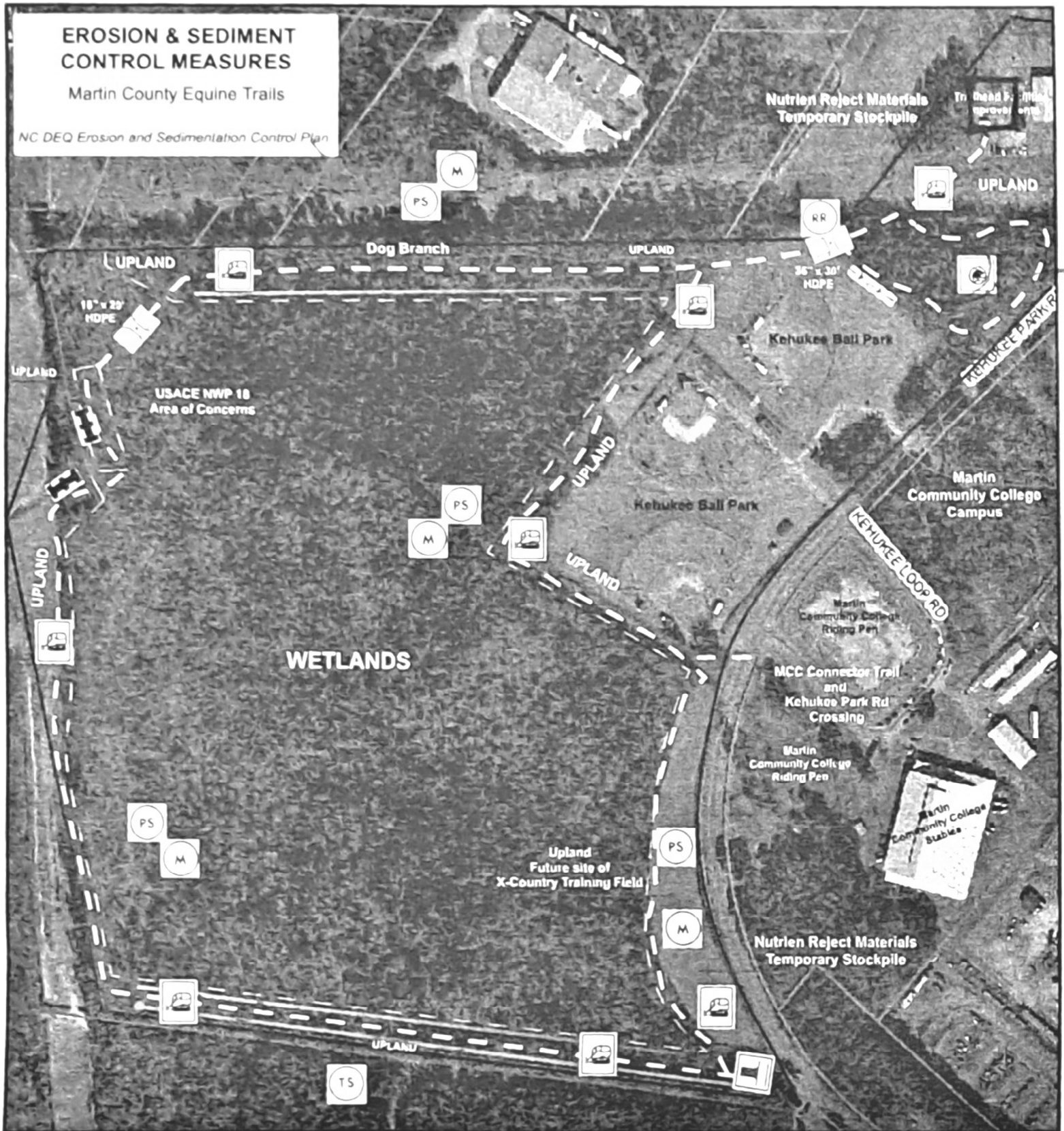
