## Notice of Nonpartisan Municipal Election Town of Parmele, North Carolina

A Nonpartisan Municipal Election will be held on Tuesday – November 5, 2019, in the *Town of Parmele*, North Carolina, for the purpose of electing *one Mayor and five Town Commissioners* for a term of 4 years. Polls will be open from 6:30 AM until 7:30 PM. The assigned polling places are:

Robersonville 1 Precinct - Robersonville Fire Department, 119 S Main Street, Robersonville Robersonville 2 Precinct - Robersonville Senior Center, 203 E Green Street, Robersonville

Absentee ballots are not allowed.

Canvass will be held at 11:00 AM in the Martin County Board of Elections Office in Williamston on Friday – November 15, 2019.

All residents of the *Town of Parmele* who are registered to vote with the Martin County Board of Elections may vote in this election. Voters who are previously registered need not re-register for this election. Those residents of the *Town of Parmele* who are not registered to vote must register on or before Friday – October 11, 2019, in order to be eligible to vote on Election Day. Voters who fail to timely make a change in name or address in the county must update their information when presenting to vote, and may be required to vote a provisional ballot.

Voters voting in person are entitled to assistance by an election official, or, if assistance is needed due to disability or illiteracy, by a qualified person of their choice. Registration facilities and voting sites are accessible to all voters. Curbside voting is available for voters who are not physically able to enter voting sites.
