 - COVID-19 Update - Adjusted Protocol for MCT. COVID-19 shots-staff

 - CARES funds allotted is a total of \$343,097. (\$16,458 Vaccination rides)
 - Free Transportation to Vaccination Sites. 7 persons transported
 - Medicaid Transformation – Modivcare and One Call contracts going on the March 10, 2021 Commissioners meeting
 - Interest in a Trillium Contract
 - Vacancies on hold - One part time driver and one full time driver.
 - Three LTV buses are ordered for the FY21 grant. 100,000 miles threshold
 - POP extension application FY 21 grant - storage building/renovation/buses
 - FY21-22 Martin County Transit Budget is being worked on.
 - FY 22 5311 grant application was submitted on December 1, 2020.
 - SSP Manual currently under revision. Drug and Alcohol section 6
 - Second Quarter FY20-21 lost revenue. During Oct., Nov., Dec. 2020 there was the loss of \$33,158.23 in total revenue due to the COVID-19 pandemic. 2019-20 second quarter had \$106,043.50 in total revenue. (Oct. to Dec. 2019) 2020-21 second quarter had \$72,885.27 in total revenue. **This represents a 31% revenue lost for Oct. to Dec. 2020**
 - January 2021 total revenue is \$21,283.15. Compared with \$33,374.20 in January 2020. This represents a revenue lost of \$12,091.05 **(36 % lost)**
