  - Martin County NC Food System Resiliency. Food box delivery. Comm. Rides Grant
  - Medicaid Transformation – Modivcare and One Call contracts update. \ We have 322 Medicaid Transportation clients that currently use MCT services. Currently at MCT 55% of revenue trips are Medicaid Transportation. At Martin County DSS altogether 3,995 beneficiaries are moving to managed care at this time.
  - COVID-19 Update - Adjusted Protocol for MCT. Federal Mask Mandate. Number of riders on buses. (current 2 to 3)
  - Agency Standards revised effective 5/1/21. (Dress Code)
  - Gas Shortage was managed.
  - Hurricane season starts 6-1-2021. Disaster Transit Teams are assigned.
  - Free Transportation to Vaccination Sites. 53 persons transported to as/of Apr.
  - Vacancies on hold - One part time driver and one full time driver.
  - Three LTV buses are coming. FY21 5311 grant. Total 6 disposed vehicles.
  - POP extension approved FY 21 grant - storage building/renovation/buses
  - A.R.Chesson Construction Company, Inc. awarded contract for renovations. 5/12/21
  - SSP Manual currently under revision. Drug and Alcohol Section 4
  - Contract Rate for Agencies. FACM cost is \$2.30 per mile. 6/9/21 agenda
  - Fee Schedule to include rates within all town limits. 6/9/21 agenda
