**System Pressure Advisory
Highway 111 Water Service Interruption**

The water customers of Martin County Water District 1 with water service addresses on **NC Highway 111** south of Oak City have experienced periods of low pressure and outages in the water distribution system on **Thursday, August 19, 2021**, due to water main repairs on NC Highway 111.

Periods of low or no pressure in the distribution system increases the potential for back siphonage and introduction of bacteria into the water system. Therefore, the water system advises that consumers **boil all water** used for human consumption (including drinking, making ice, brushing teeth, washing dishes and food preparation) or use bottled water. Vigorous boiling for one (1) minute should kill any disease-causing organisms that may be present in the water.

This advisory remains in effect until further written notification is issued.
