Register for 24/7 access to your case information.

MiChildSupport allows you to access your child support case information any time you need it. The site is mobile friendly; most customers use it with a mobile device. You can communicate with your Friend of the Court, ask questions and attach documents. You can sign up to receive text notifications, such as “payment received”

IMPORTANT:

As of 12/10/20: MiChildSupport users will now log on using MILogin, Michigan's Single Sign-on solution for doing business with the state. If you are a current [MIBridges, Unemployment, or Secretary of State, or MIWAM](#) user, you already have a MILogin account. Be sure to click on 'Already have a MILogin Account' when you do your one time sign-up. There is a link for a self help guide if you have trouble signing in.

HOW TO SIGN UP FOR MICHILD SUPPORT

GO TO MICASE.STATE.MI.US



If you already have a MiLogin for any other application such as MiWam, Secretary of State, or MDHHS you will click on “Already Have MiLogin Account”

If you have no existing accounts with Michigan.gov click on “Create a MiLogin Account”

After creating a login or if you already have a MiLogin you will need to log in for Step 2



ACCESS TO MICHILDSUPPORT

Go to the Menu – Click “Request Access”

Select Agency and scroll down to Michigan Department of Health and Human Services

Click the “MiChildSupport” department link and verify information.

Return to Home Page and log out



LOGIN TO MILOGIN AGAIN

When you log in, the MiChildSupport link should now be on your home page.

Click the “MiChildSupport” link and you will link with your current MiChildSupport account.

Verify your identity after answering questions.

VERIFY EMAIL



You will receive an email from the MiChildSupport website verifying your account.

A code is sent to your email. Once the code is entered, you should have full access to MiChildSupport

USE MICHILDSUPPORT



Access case information 24/7 from anywhere that you have internet service.

Check payment status, hearing dates, payment summaries, amount owed, and get alerts for changes to your case.
