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MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

OCTOBER 4, 2011


The Middletown Town Council met for its regularly scheduled meeting on October 4, 2011 in the Council Meeting Room at 653 Locust Street, Middletown, Indiana at 7:00 P.M. The meeting was opened by Council President Tim Mundell. Clerk-Treasurer Jim Hanson noted that Council Members Lisa Hicks, Jim Mundell, Bill Harrison and Betty Riley were present. Also present was counsel for the council, Greg Crider. Tim led those present in the recitation of the Pledge to the flag. Minutes from the previous meeting were approved as presented.


1. Council President Tim Mundell informed council that he was calling for an executive session prior to the next regular meeting. Formal notices will be posted in a timely manner. He reported that the duct system in the Municipal Building had been cleaned as decided at the last meeting at a cost of \$2500. Tim announced that the new truck for the police department had arrived. Since the department will no longer need the 2002 Ford Explorer, he made a motion that the town receives sealed bids for the 2002 Explorer in the Clerk-Treasurer's Office at 653 Locust Street, Middletown, In 47356 until noon on November 1, 2011. Council Member Jim Mundell seconded the motion, All voted in favor of the motion. In a final note, Mundell reminded everyone that the New Castle Henry County Chamber OF Commerce would be hosting a candidate forum on Thursday, October 6, 2011 at 6:30 P.M. in the Training Room at the Municipal Building at 653 Locust Street, Middletown, In 47356. This is an opportunity for the community to meet the candidates for the upcoming election and to hear their responses to questions posed by the moderator.


2. EMS Chief Phil Chandler reported that work was progressing on the modification of the town's FCC licenses. He also gave council copies of his department run sheets for September.


3. Utility Superintendent Tracy Harrison reported that customers with security lights who wish to replace them with the new LED Fixtures could do so. The cost for the LED Light is \$337 for a 55Watt light. If there is enough interest, a better cost could be obtained if we order larger quantities of the fixtures. Also Tracy gave the council copies of a proposal for Electrical 12KV distribution system improvements from Burns Corporation. Denny Burns will be at the next meeting to answer questions from the council.


4. There being nothing further to come before council, the meeting was adjourned.
