## MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

JULY5, 2011

The Middletown Town Council met for its regularly scheduled meeting on July 5, 2011 in the Council Meeting Room at 653 Locust Street, Middletown, Indiana at 7:00 P.M. The meeting was opened by Council President Tim Mundell. Clerk-Treasurer Jim Hanson noted that Council Members Bill Harrison, Lisa Hicks, Jim Mundell and Betty Riley were all present. Also present was counsel for the council, Joel Harvey. Tim led those present in the recitation of the Pledge to the flag. Minutes from the previous meeting were approved as presented.

- 1. Council President Tim Mundell gave council copies of proposal from Muncie Paving for proposed street and alley repairs in the town. These will be considered at the next meeting.
- 2. Dispatch Supervisor Lavonna Robbins proposed hiring Betsy Mills as a part time dispatcher to fill voids when the regular dispatchers are unavailable for work. Betsy formerly worked here as dispatcher and would require only minimal training. Bill Harrison made a motion to hire Betsy as a part time dispatcher at the entry rate of \$8.49 per hour. Jim Mundell seconded. Bill, Jim, Betty and Tim voted yea. Lisa voted nay. Motion carried.
- 3. Fire Chief Brian Rednour informed council that he had spoken to a Madison County attorney who had handled the formation of fire territories in that county. The attorney is willing to come before council and explain the procedure at council's convenience. Brian will bring the attorney to the next regular meeting.
- 4. Clerk-Treasurer Jim Hanson brought council up to date on the letters that were sent out concerning the un-metered security lights and the unkempt properties that had been reported to his office.
- 5. Dick Schwalm reminded those present that the Utility Advisory Board would meet the next day, July 6, 2011 at 12:15 P.M. in the council meeting room. All are invited to attend.
- 6. EMS Chief Phil Chandler gave his report on the runs made by his department for the month and for the year to date.

7. There being nothing further to come before council, the meeting was adjourned.
