MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

JULY19, 2011

The Middletown Town Council met for its regularly scheduled meeting on July 19, 2011 in the Council Meeting Room at 653 Locust Street, Middletown, Indiana at 7:00 P.M. The meeting was opened by Council President Tim Mundell. Clerk-Treasurer Jim Hanson noted that Council Members Lisa Hicks, Jim Mundell and Betty Riley were present. Bill Harrison was absent due to illness. Also present was counsel for the council, Greg Crider. Tim led those present in the recitation of the Pledge to the flag. Minutes from the previous meeting were approved as presented.

- 1. President Mundell presented Kurt Tucker from Koorsen Fire & Security, Indianapolis, IN. Kurt made a presentation to council of estimates for video security surveillance at the utility plants. After discussion, the council tabled the proposals.
- 2. Fire Chief Brian Rednour introduced Stephen Schuyler, an Anderson attorney specializing in the organization of Fire Territories. Mr. Schuyler presented the council with the basic information on how to establish a Fire Territory. He informed them on deadlines that must be met, estimated costs involved and consultants that were available to help with establishing tax rates for said Fire Territory. Mr. Schuyler fielded questions from council and from the audience. No action was taken.
- 3. Quotes for paving and repair of certain streets and alleys in the Town of Middletown were brought to the table. Councilmember Jim Mundell asked that council wait until next meeting to make the decision when all members are present. The matter was tabled.
- 4. Councilmember Betty Riley mentioned to council that many of the sidewalks in town are in need of repair or replacement. No decision was made about sidewalks at this time.
- 5. Councilmember Lisa Hicks inquired as to whether or not the alert siren on N. 6th Street was fully functional. Brian Rednour said he would follow up and report back to council.

6. There being nothing further to come before council, the meeting was adjourned.
