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MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
APRIL 17, 2012

The Middletown Town Council met for its regularly scheduled meeting on April 17, 2012 in the Training Room at 653 Locust Street, Middletown, Indiana at 7:00 P.M. The meeting was opened by Town Council President Betty Riley leading those present in the pledge to the flag. Clerk-Treasurer Drew Cooper noted that Council Members Betty Riley, Bill Harrison, Norm Purdue, Shelly Kimmerling and Danny Justice were present. Counsel for the town council Joel Harvey was present.

1. Norm Purdue moved to set the Town's contribution to employee's Health Savings Accounts to \$70 for all employees. Danny Justice seconded. Shelly Kimmerling, Danny Justice and Norm Purdue voted yes. Bill Harrison and Betty Riley voted no. The motion passed.

2. Bill Harrison moved to set the speed limit on all streets in Middletown to 20 Miles Per Hour. Shelly Kimmerling seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

3. Betty Riley moved to suspend the rules and pass Ordinance No. 4-2012 AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE REGULATION OF GOLF CARTS on all three readings in one meeting. The new ordinance would amend the ordinance passed at the previous meeting by substituting the word "golf cart" in place of "alternative transportation". The motion passed unanimously on all three readings.





4. Norm Purdue moved to use \$110,000 of Stormwater Fund to pay off some of the bonds owed on the 7<sup>th</sup> Street Sewer Separation Project. Danny Justice seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

5. Police Chief Tony Robbins gave the town council a proposed K-9 policy to consider for approval. No action was taken on that policy.

6. Betty Riley moved to approve the appointment of Kenny Jasper as a reserve police officer. Norm Purdue seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

7. Clerk-Treasurer Drew Cooper advised the council that he will meet with all the department heads to create a final draft of the town's drug test policy for the May 1<sup>st</sup> town council meeting.

8. There being nothing further to come before council, the meeting was adjourned.
