MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
MAY 15, 2012

The Middletown Town Council met for its regularly scheduled meeting on May 15, 2012 in the Training Room at 653 Locust Street, Middletown, Indiana at 7:00 P.M. The meeting was opened by Town Council President Betty Riley leading those present in the pledge to the flag. Clerk-Treasurer Drew Cooper noted that Council Members Betty Riley, Bill Harrison, Norm Purdue, and Danny Justice were present. Counsel for the town council Joel Harvey was present.

1. Clerk-Treasurer Drew Cooper led a discussion on a proposed Middletown Utilities Billing & Collections Policy. No action was taken on the matter.
2. Town Marshall Tony Robbins reported that the Police Department's Crown Vic was sold at auction for \$850. The town should net \$760 after auction fees. Norm Purdue moved that Robbins be given permission to use the funds to purchase a hand-held radar gun. Betty Riley seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
3. Danny Justice moved to give permission to Officer Mike Vacarro to use the town's police vehicle when attending K-9 training inside Henry County. Bill Harrison seconded. Justice, Harrison, and Purdue voted yes. Riley voted no. The motion passed.
4. Norm Purdue moved to give permission to Utilities Superintendent Tracy Harrison to hire 4 teens for 8 weeks during the summer at minimum wage. Betty Riley seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
5. At the request of Superintendent Harrison, the council scheduled an executive session, followed by a special public meeting, for Friday, May 18, 9:00 a.m. at the Public Meeting Room.
6. There being nothing further to come before council, the meeting was adjourned.
