MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
JUNE 12, 2012

The Middletown Town Council met for its regularly scheduled meeting on June 12, 2012 in the Public Meeting Room at 653 Locust Street, Middletown, Indiana at 7:00 P.M. The meeting was opened by Town Council President Betty Riley leading those present in the pledge to the flag. Clerk-Treasurer Drew Cooper noted that Council Members Betty Riley, Bill Harrison, Norm Purdue, Shelly Kimmerling and Danny Justice were present. Counsel for the town council Joel Harvey was present.

1. Norm Purdue moved to authorize the Clerk-Treasurer to give the public 3 months to come forward and claim water, sewer, and electric deposits that are currently held on closed utility accounts over 7 years old. After this 3 month period (September 30, 2012) the abandoned deposits will become the property of the Town of Middletown and will be placed in the appropriate utility operating funds. This 3 month period, in which to claim deposits, will be advertised in the local newspaper. Betty Riley seconded the motion. Purdue, Riley, Shelly Kimmerling, and Danny Justice voted yes. Bill Harrison voted no. The motion passed.







2. Norm Purdue moved to authorize Utility Superintendent Tracy Harrison to purchase a new automated chlorinator valve for the water utility, for an approximate cost of \$5000. Bill Harrison seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

3. Betty Riley moved to authorize the Clerk-Treasurer to transfer \$1375 from the Riverboat Fund to the Civic Center Fund in order to pay invoices that have been held up due to lack of funds. Norm Purdue seconded the motion. Riley, Purdue, Justice, and Kimmerling voted yes. Harrison voted no. The motion passed.

4. Norm Purdue moved to give permission to Cable TV Liaison Ron Koons and Clerk-Treasurer Drew Cooper to negotiate a higher pole rental fee with Comcast and AT&T. The current annual rate is \$2.80 per pole for AT&T, and \$4.25 per pole for Comcast. Betty Riley seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

5. Norm Purdue moved to authorize the Clerk-Treasurer to transfer \$39895.60 from the FEMA Disaster Relief Fund, \$18906.18 from the Water Operating Fund, \$18906.18 from the Sewer Operating Fund, and \$18906.19 from the Electric Operating Fund, to the Payroll Fund in order to eliminate the negative balance. Danny Justice seconded the motion. Kimmerling, Justice, Riley, and Purdue voted yes. Harrison voted no. The motion passed.

6. There being nothing further to come before council, the meeting was adjourned.
