MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
JULY 17, 2012

The Middletown Town Council met for its regularly scheduled meeting on July 17, 2012 in the Training Room at 653 Locust Street, Middletown, Indiana at 7:00 P.M. The meeting was opened by Town Council President Betty Riley leading those present in the pledge to the flag. Clerk-Treasurer Drew Cooper noted that Council Members Betty Riley, Bill Harrison, Danny Justice, Norm Purdue, and Shelly Kimmerling were present. Counsel for the town council Greg Crider was present.

1. A public hearing was held on an additional appropriation as follows:

Lease/Rental Fund	\$49,000.00
Civic Center Fund	\$ 1,375.00
Riverboat Fund	\$ 5,375.00
Park Fund	\$ 1,276.00


Clerk-Treasurer Drew Cooper explained that the appropriation for the Lease/Rental Fund was needed due to the December 2011 payment not being made until January 2012. The Civic Center appropriation was due to extra maintenance expenses. The Riverboat Fund appropriation was for two transfers, \$1,375 to the Civic Center Fund and \$4000 to the Lease/Rental Fund. The Park Fund appropriation was to allow the Park Board to use the funds derived from the sale of a lawn mower. The council voted unanimously to approve the additional appropriation Resolution 07-17-2012-1.


2. Betty Riley moved to authorize the Utilities Superintendent to hire Todd Swinford as an electrical lineman. Bill Harrison seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.


3. Danny Justice moved to set the fine for speeding at \$25 in the proposed ordinance setting the town speed limit to 25 MPH. Norm Purdue seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.




5. There being nothing further to come before council, the meeting was adjourned.
