MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
AUGUST 7, 2012

The Middletown Town Council met for its regularly scheduled meeting on August 7, 2012 in the Public Meeting Room at 653 Locust Street, Middletown, Indiana at 7:00 P.M. The meeting was opened by Town Council President Betty Riley leading those present in the pledge to the flag. Clerk-Treasurer Drew Cooper noted that Council Members Betty Riley, Bill Harrison, Danny Justice, Norm Purdue, and Shelly Kimmerling were present. Counsel for the town council Joel Harvey was present.

1. A public hearing was held on an additional appropriation as follows:

Clerk-Treasurer Drew Cooper explained that the appropriation for the Tax Increment Fund was to reimburse Kenny Norfleet for invoices he paid in 2007 during the construction of the Norfleet Business Park. The appropriation for the Cum Cap Development Fund was to pay for repairs to the Police Department air conditioning unit and other possible repairs needed to the Municipal Building for the remainder of 2012. Norm Purdue moved to approve the additional appropriation. Betty Riley seconded. The council voted unanimously to approve the additional appropriation Resolution 08-07-2012-1.

2. Norm Purdue moved to authorize the Clerk-Treasurer to move \$1500 of budget from the Fire Dept Operating account 101203422.000 to the Fire/Garage and Motor account 101203422.020, and also \$1500 of budget from the Fire/Equip Rpr Parts account 101203423.020 to the Fire/Garage and Motor account 101203422.020. Betty Riley seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

3. Norm Purdue moved to pass ordinance 7-2012 AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS WITHIN THE TOWN OF MIDDLETOWN, INDIANA on its first reading. Betty Riley seconded. The ordinance passed unanimously on its first reading.

4. Norm Purdue moved to pass ordinance 8-2012 AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE POLICE DONATIONS FUND. Betty Riley seconded. The council moved to suspend the rules and passed all three readings of the ordinance unanimously.

5. Norm Purdue moved to authorize the Clerk-Treasurer to transfer \$1000 from the General Fund, which had been receipted from the sale of rifle parts earlier this year, into the newly created Police Donations Fund. Town Marshal Tony Robbins has certified that the rifle parts were not originally purchased with General Fund tax money and therefore the money received from the sale could be considered a private donation to the police department. Betty Riley seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

6. Utilities Superintendent Tracy Harrison advised the council that the town code needed updating as to ordinances dealing with nails, staples, screws, etc., used to attach signs to utility poles. Joel Harvey said he would investigate the matter.

7. There being nothing further to come before council, the meeting was adjourned.
