MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
 DECEMBER 4, 2012

The Middletown Town Council met for its regularly scheduled meeting on December 4, 2012 in the Public Meeting Room at 653 Locust Street, Middletown, Indiana at 7:00 P.M. The meeting was opened by Town Council President Betty Riley leading those present in the pledge to the flag. Clerk-Treasurer Drew Cooper noted that Council Members Betty Riley, Shelly Kimmerling, Bill Harrison, and Norm Purdue were present. Counsel for the town council Greg Crider was present.

1. Clerk-Treasurer Drew Cooper reported to the council on a recent meeting he attended with representatives from the engineering firm of Butler-Fairman-Seaufert on the phase one sewer separation project. The council requested that the Clerk-Treasurer schedule a presentation by BFS at a future town council meeting. The presentation should spell out possible timelines and funding options available for the project.

2. The council reviewed several estimates by HVAC contractors for preventative maintenance agreements for the Municipal Building, Civic Center, and Treatment Plant furnaces. No decision was made.

3. A public hearing was held on budget moves in the General Fund:
