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MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
SEPTEMBER 3, 2013

The Middletown Town Council met for its regularly scheduled meeting on September 3, 2013 in the Public Meeting Room at 653 Locust Street, Middletown, Indiana at 7:00 P.M. The meeting was opened by Town Council President Betty Riley leading those present in the pledge to the flag. Clerk-Treasurer Drew Cooper noted that Council Members Betty Riley, Bill Harrison, Gary Kendall, and Norm Purdue were present. Town Attorney Joel Harvey was present.

1. Norm Purdue moved to suspend the rules and conduct the third reading of Ordinance 3-2013 AN ORDINANCE INCREASING RATES CHARGED TO CUSTOMERS OF THE MIDDLETOWN WATER UTILITY by title only. Gary Kendall seconded. The motion passed unanimously. Betty Riley moved to approve ordinance 3-2013 on the third reading. Norm Purdue seconded. The motion passed unanimously.




2. A public hearing was held on additional appropriations for the Cumulative Capital Development Fund for \$40,000 and the Cumulative Capital Improvement Fund for \$30,000. There were no comments from the public. Betty Riley moved to approve the additional appropriations. Norm Purdue seconded. The motion passed unanimously.




3. The council instructed the Town Attorney to investigate state laws on the prohibition of large trucks parking on the street in residential neighborhoods and report back at the next meeting.

4. Bill Harrison moved to authorize the Utilities Superintendent to create a new access to the Municipal Building attic in the main hallway, the expenditure to be paid for from the Cumulative Capital Development Fund. Norm Purdue seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

5. Betty Riley moved to authorize the Utilities Superintendent to hire Rick Shewmaker to replace the siding on the Municipal Building for \$30,000, the expenditure to be paid for from the Cumulative Capital Development Fund. Bill Harrison seconded. Betty Riley, Bill Harrison, and Gary Kendall voted yes. Norm Purdue voted no. The motion passed.
