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MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
OCTOBER 1, 2013

The Middletown Town Council met for its regularly scheduled meeting on October 1, 2013 in the Public Meeting Room at 653 Locust Street, Middletown, Indiana at 7:00 P.M. The meeting was opened by Acting Town Council President Norm Purdue leading those present in the pledge to the flag. Town Council President Betty Riley was absent. Clerk-Treasurer Drew Cooper noted that Council Members Bill Harrison, Gary Kendall, Shelly Kimmerling, and Norm Purdue were present. Town Attorney Joel Harvey was present.




1. Corey Murphy, of the Henry County EDC, presented a plan to grant local business man Mike Anderson a three-year tax abatement on his property at State Road 236. Anderson plans to build a \$400,000 expansion to his business, Metal Art, which will provide 10 new jobs over a three-year period. The Council instructed the town attorney to investigate the steps required to grant this tax abatement.



2. The Council discussed the proposed town ordinance prohibiting large trucks from parking on the street in residential neighborhoods. Shelly Kimmerling moved to table the discussion. Gary Kendall seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

3. Norm Purdue moved to authorize the Clerk-Treasurer to transfer \$5000 from the Riverboat Fund to the Civic Center Fund. Gary Kendall seconded. Kimmerling, Kendall, and Purdue voted yes. Harrison voted no. The motion passed.

4. The Council decided by consensus to set the Halloween Trick-or-Treating hours in Middletown from 6-9 p.m. on Thursday, October 31.
