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MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
JULY 15, 2014

The Middletown Town Council met for its regularly scheduled meeting on July 15, 2014 in the Public Meeting Room at 653 Locust Street, Middletown, Indiana at 7:00 P.M. The meeting was opened by Town Council President Betty Riley leading those present in the pledge to the flag. Clerk-Treasurer Drew Cooper noted that Council Members Betty Riley, Gary Kendall, Bill Harrison, and Norm Purdue were present. Shelly Kimmerling was absent. Town Attorney Joel Harvey was present.

1. Betty Riley reported that one estimate has been received on replacing the sidewalk and steps in front of the Civic Center.
2. The Clerk-Treasurer presented a flyer to be included in the utility bills about the proposed sidewalk replacement loans to property owners. The Town Council agreed by consensus to allow the inserting of the flyers in the next billing. The Town Attorney said he would review the document.
3. Betty Riley moved to change the police academy contract for deputies to a term of 2 years with a payback of \$3000 if the deputy leaves Middletown within one year of finishing the academy, and \$1000 if the deputy leaves between one year and two years after finishing the academy. Bill Harrison seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
4. Norm Purdue moved to authorize the Utility Superintendent to purchase separate diesel fuel tanks for the Municipal Building, one for the generator and one for Fire/EMS vehicles. Bill Harrison seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
5. There being nothing further to come before council, the meeting was adjourned.
