MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
AUGUST 5, 2014

The Middletown Town Council met for its regularly scheduled meeting on August 5, 2014 in the Public Meeting Room at 653 Locust Street, Middletown, Indiana at 7:00 P.M. The meeting was opened by Town Council President Betty Riley leading those present in the pledge to the flag. Clerk-Treasurer Drew Cooper noted that Council Members Betty Riley, Gary Kendall, Bill Harrison, Shelly Kimmerling and Norm Purdue were present. Town Attorney Joel Harvey was present.

1. Betty Riley moved to authorize the Town Marshall to hire Andrew Williams as a new full-time Middletown Police Officer at the Deputy 4 pay rate and Kim Cronk as a part-time officer at the same rate. Gary Kendall seconded. The motion passed unanimously. Officer Williams was immediately sworn in by the Clerk-Treasurer.
2. Norm Purdue moved to present the estimates from Improvements Unlimited and J&W Construction to the County Commissioners for receiving a \$9000 Food & Beverage grant to replace the sidewalks and paint the front of the Civic Center. Shelly Kimmerling seconded. The motion passed unanimously. Norm Purdue moved to recommend using Improvements Unlimited to the Commissioners, given they had the lowest cost estimate. Bill Harrison seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
3. Betty Riley moved to authorize Change Order #2 for the 5th Street Stormsewer Project. The change order, which includes several new water main valves for Locust Street that were not in the original project plans, will increase the total payout to 3-D Company by \$19,629.41. Norm Purdue seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
4. There being nothing further to come before council, the meeting was adjourned.
