MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
SEPTEMBER 2, 2014

The Middletown Town Council met for its regularly scheduled meeting on September 2, 2014 in the Public Meeting Room at 653 Locust Street, Middletown, Indiana at 7:00 P.M. The meeting was opened by Town Council President Betty Riley leading those present in the pledge to the flag. Clerk-Treasurer Drew Cooper noted that Council Members Betty Riley, Gary Kendall, Bill Harrison, Shelly Kimmerling and Norm Purdue were present. Town Attorney Joel Harvey was present.

1. Based on the recommendation of the Utilities Superintendent, Betty Riley moved to promote Utility Worker Carl Spears to Grade 7. Gary Kendall seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

2. Shelly Kimmerling moved to not require rummage sale permits for sales taking place during this year's Fall Fun Fest, scheduled for October 3-4. Betty Riley seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

3. Betty Riley moved to approve change order #3 of the 5th Street Storm Sewer Project. This change involves installing a 24" storm sewer main through the field next to Trace Engineering to eliminate the existing 12" combined sewer pipe that runs under the building and another older 18" combined sewer pipe running through the field. According to engineering estimates from Butler-Fairman-Seufert, the change will cost an additional \$58,000 which will come out of the contingency budget of the State Revolving Fund loan. Shelly Kimmerling seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

4. Norm Purdue moved to set the Trick-or-treat night in Middletown to Friday, October 31, from 6-9 p.m. Betty Riley seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

5. There being nothing further to come before council, the meeting was adjourned.
