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MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
MARCH 17, 2015

The Middletown Town Council met for its regularly scheduled meeting on March 17, 2015 in the Public Meeting Room at 653 Locust Street, Middletown, Indiana at 7:00 P.M. The meeting was opened by Town Council President Betty Riley leading those present in the pledge to the flag. Clerk-Treasurer Drew Cooper noted that Council Members Betty Riley, Dave Wagner, Gary Kendall, Shelly Kimmerling, and Norm Purdue were present. Town Attorney Joel Harvey was present.

1. Betty Riley moved to approve the SRF Loan Program PER Acceptance Resolution, which authorizes submitting the Water Treatment Plant Replacement Project Preliminary Engineering Report to the Indiana Finance Authority State Revolving Fund. Gary Kendall seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
2. Matt Spidel, of Butler-Fairman-Seufert, presented 5th Street Storm Sewer Project change orders number 18 & 19. Utilities Superintendent Tracy Harrison objected to the town being charged for camera video inspection of existing sewers, as itemized on change order number 18. Spidel said a project status meeting would be held with the contractor on March 24 and that this issue would be investigated at that meeting.
3. The Town Council President directed the town attorney to investigate a possible ordinance for restrictive parking prior to eminent snow storms and report back at the next town council meeting.
4. The Town Council President directed the town attorney to create a resolution to incorporate state and federal law on military leave into the town employee policy manual. The town council will consider this resolution at the next meeting.
5. Dave Wagner moved to authorize the Middletown Lions Club to hold their annual fair parade on Middletown streets during the first week of June 2015. Norm Purdue seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
6. Betty Riley moved to approve a new contract with Comcast for annual pole rental fees. The new contract would increase the rental fee from \$4.25 per pole to \$6.23 per pole. Gary Kendall seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
7. Dave Wagner moved to hire Travis Rider and Adam Waters as full-time Utility Workers Grade 2. Betty Riley seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
8. There being nothing further to come before council, the meeting was adjourned.
