MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
JULY 7, 2015

The Middletown Town Council met for its regularly scheduled meeting on July 7, 2015 in the Public Meeting Room at 653 Locust Street, Middletown, Indiana at 7:00 P.M. The meeting was opened by Town Council President Betty Riley leading those present in the pledge to the flag. Clerk-Treasurer Drew Cooper noted that Council Members Betty Riley, Dave Wagner, Shelly Kimmerling and Norm Purdue were present. Council Member Gary Kendall was absent. Town Attorney Joel Harvey was present.

1. Corey Murphy, from the Henry County Economic Development Corporation, gave a presentation on recent activities of the EDC. Dave Wagner volunteered to serve as a representative of Middletown on the Brown Field EPA Grant Steering Committee.
2. Dave Wagner moved to authorize the Town Marshall to purchase 3 rifles for \$1,860 using the Police Continuing Education Fund. Norm Purdue seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
3. Council President Betty Riley left the meeting due to a family emergency. Norm Purdue took over her duties.
4. Dave Wagner moved to authorize the Town Marshall to purchase 4 vehicle gun racks for \$2,240 using the Police Continuing Education Fund. Shelly Kimmerling seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
5. A public hearing was held on an additional appropriation of \$30,000 for the Local Road & Street Fund. Dave Wagner moved to approve RESOLUTION 2015-07-07-01 A RESOLUTION APPROVING ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS TO CERTAIN FUNDS. Shelly Kimmerling seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
6. Matt Spidel, of Butler-Fairmain-Seafurt, reported that OCRA has \$1,000,000 grants available for storm water flood prevention projects. Applications are due on September 11, 2015. A meeting was scheduled for July 10 with the town's grant writers to discuss a possible grant application.
7. There being nothing further to come before council, the meeting was adjourned.
