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MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
MARCH 7, 2017

The Middletown Town Council met on March 7, 2017 in the Public Meeting Room at 653 Locust Street, Middletown, Indiana at 7:00 P.M. The meeting was opened by Town Council President Jake Smith leading those present in the pledge to the flag. Clerk-Treasurer Drew Cooper noted that Council Members Jake Smith, Betty Riley, Dave Wagner, Donita Chambless, and Gary Kendall were present. Town Attorney Joel Harvey was present.

1. Dave Wagner moved to hire Angela Smith as a Dispatcher Grade 1. Donita Chambless seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
2. Donita Chambless moved to authorize the Clerk-Treasurer to pay an invoice for \$150 to the Henry County Human Society for securing a dog during a recent eviction performed by the Henry County Sheriff's Department in Middletown. Dave Wagner seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
3. Dave Wagner moved to authorize the Utilities Superintendent to apply for an OCRA planning grant to fund the design of updates to the Waste Water Treatment Plant. Gary Kendall seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
4. Matt Spidel, of Butler-Fairman-Seufert, announced the ribbon cutting for the new Water Treatment Plant is scheduled for Tuesday, April 18, 6:00 p.m., just before the regularly scheduled town council meeting.
5. Spidel presented change order number 1 for the 8th Street Storm Sewer Project. The change order, which totals \$28,620, is for 3 water valves inserted into water mains on 8th and Maple Streets. Dave Wagner moved to approve the change order. Donita Chambless seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

There being nothing further to come before council, the meeting was adjourned.
