


MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

February 4th 2020

The Middletown Town Council met in the Public Meeting Room at 653 Locust Street, Middletown, Indiana at 7:00 P.M. Council Members Dick Schwalm, Gary Kendall, Dan Fountain, and Jake Smith were Present. Dave Wagner was absent. Town Attorney Joel Harvey was present.


1. Jake Smith and the entire council presented the first annual Chauncey Burr award to Rex and June Slick for their contributions to the community.
2. Donita Chambless, Deann Connor and Susan Smith will serve on a committee to research and acquire new Christmas lights for the town. They are applying for a HCCF grant.
3. Resolution 2020-02-04-1, a resolution to purchase a new police vehicle, was presented. Dan Fountain motioned and Jake Smith seconded for passage of the resolution. Motion carried 4-0.
4. We will schedule a presentation from the company wanting to revamp the town website for the February 18th meeting.
5. Police Chief Amanda Riwitis gave a report on the Reserve Officer dinner held by the county. Collin Casstevens was Middletown Reserve Officer of the year.
6. Chief Riwitis had a quote from John Ashton for replacing the door in the police station. The council requested more quotes before proceeding.
7. Resident Steve Sheets questioned having trash service at a residence that is empty. He was told if he shut the water off at the residence that he would not have to have the trash service.
8. Patty Schwalm reported that the new sump pump has been installed in the Civic Center elevator shaft. There is also receptacle and light fixture in the pit that need replaced.
9. Gary Kendall asked about the progress of a utility theft ordinance.


There being nothing further to come before the council, the meeting was adjourned.
