




# MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES




February 18<sup>th</sup> 2020

The Middletown Town Council met in the Public Meeting Room at 653 Locust Street, Middletown, Indiana at 7:00 P.M. Council Members Dick Schwalm, Gary Kendall, Dan Fountain, Jake Smith and Dave Wagner were present. Town Attorney Joel Harvey was present.

1. Revize Software gave an online presentation on rebuilding the town website.
2. The council discussed Christmas lights and how the conversion to LED bulbs might lead to energy cost savings.
3. Fire Chief Brian Rednour reported that people would be in town on Tuesday, February 25<sup>th</sup> to test the town water system for ISO rating.
4. Police Chief Amanda Riwitis reported she had an agreement to sell a truck vault to Delaware County for 500.00. Dave Wagner motioned and Dan Fountain seconded approving the sale. Motion carried 5-0.
5. Ron Koons gave a report on the town electrical usage.
6. The council approved and signed a new agreement with Baker-Tilly for calculating our electric tracker. The fee increased from 750.00 to 800.00 per quarter.
7. Dave Wagner motioned and Dan Fountain seconded approving the updated documents for our 403B with First Merchants. Motion carried 5-0.
8. Dave Wagner discussed having a meeting with Fall Creek Township to discuss Air Pack funding.
9. Dan Fountain discussed having high school students create a town logo
10. Dick Schwalm questioned the inspection and getting a permit for the Civic Center elevator.
