


MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES


March 3rd 2020


The Middletown Town Council met in the Public Meeting Room at 653 Locust Street, Middletown, Indiana at 7:00 P.M. Council Members Dick Schwalm, Gary Kendall, Dan Fountain, Jake Smith and Dave Wagner were present. Town Attorney Joel Harvey was present.

1. After some discussion, Dave Wagner moved and Dick Schwalm seconded to table the website overhaul. Motion carried 4-1 with Gary Kendall voting no.
2. Gary Kendall had a discussion with Carl Spears about electrical problems at a local residence.
3. Carl Spears requested a new dialer system for the water plant from Peerless Midwest at a cost of 6206.00. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving the purchase. Motion carried 5-0.
4. Carl Spears gave a quote from Attlin Construction of 2735.00 to repair the door in the police station. The council took it under advisement.
5. Carl Spears requested to purchase a 4 post 12000 pound vehicle lift to be installed in the utility garage for a cost of 5245.00. Gary Kendall motioned and Dave Wagner seconded to approve the purchase. Motion carried 5-0.
6. Carl Spears requested permission for Richard Hollingworth and Carl Spears to attend a conference of the Indiana Rural Water Alliance in French Lick on March 18-19. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded allowing them to attend. Motion carried 5-0.
7. Carl Spears requested permission to sell the old bed off of a utility truck for 500.00 to Jason Masters. Dave Wagner motioned and Dick Schwalm seconded allowing the sale. Motion carried 5-0.
8. Dan Fountain gave a list of appointments to various boards.
9. Joel Harvey gave a report on switching from a Town Marshall to a Police Department. Dave Wagner motioned and Dan Fountain seconded allowing Amanda Riwitis to attend police chief school if she can reserve a spot. Motion carried 5-0
10. Dave Wagner motioned and Dick Schwalm seconded allowing the Police Department to purchase lights for the new Police Truck from Feniex Lighting for 2444.00. Motion carried 5-0.

There being nothing further to come before the council, the meeting was adjourned.
