


MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES


April 21st 2020


The Middletown Town Council met via the GoToMeeting App at 7:00 P.M. Council Members Dick Schwalm, Gary Kendall, Jake Smith, Dave Wagner and Town Attorney Joel Harvey were present. Dan Fountain was absent.


1. A request was made by Jeff and Kerry Purdy to make the alley between 10th and 11th just North of Locust Street one-way. It would be one-way heading east to accommodate a drive thru window at a new business. Dave Wagner motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving the request. Motion carried 4-0. An ordinance will be prepared.
2. There was some discussion on the IMPA tracking fee. No action has been taken so far to correct the under billing from last summer.
3. The council was given a report on the town's financial position. There are some investments that could be used on an emergency basis if needed during the Health Emergency
4. Amanda Riwitis thanked Individual Support Services for the donation of medical gloves to the Police Department.
5. Jake Smith reported that Corey Murphy of the Henry County Economic Development had spoken with him about the Town possibly donating money to a fund that would be used for small business loans. These loans would be used to help local businesses recover from being shutdown during the Public Health Emergency.


There being nothing further to come before the council, the meeting was adjourned.


